Certification Requirements for Foreign Educated Technologists

- A. Candidate shall submit the following documents:
 - 1. Official Birth Certificate
 - 2. Name change documentation if applicable
 - 3. Social Security number
 - 4. Copy of licensure or certification from country of original licensure
 - 5. Copy of all transcripts from Radiologic program with course descriptions
 - 6. All documents must be translated into English

- B. Procedure:
 - 1. Complete application for permanent certification
 - 2. Provide documents as noted above
 - 3. Provide \$50 application fee
 - 4. Complete application to take the State Radiography, Therapy, Nuclear Medicine, Bone Densitometry or Limited Scope exam
 - 5. Provide \$65 exam fee (must be a certified check or cashier's check made payable to the A.R.R.T)
 - 6. Transcripts will be reviewed to ensure the courses meet SCRQSA standards

- C. Examination
 - 1. Candidate must take and pass the state applicable exam in their scope of practice.

- D. Candidate cannot practice until such time as the Committee and Board have approved the application and candidate has passed the state exam.
